



Rafting in the Napo-River



We are leaving Tena at 9 AM, 45 minutes later we will arrive at the **Jatun Yacu River** near the **Llanganates National Park**. Once we arrived at the river, we will explain how to handle a raftingboat. After the security instructions there will be enough time to practice with the boat.

The distance of our trip down the river is **26 kilometers**, the duration depends on the water level. Normaly it will take us between **4 and 6 hours** to Puerto Napo, the destination of our trip. The river Jatun Yacu is one of the best white-water rivers of Ecuador.

We will **stop 2 times**

- To visit a little indigenous museum in an indegenous community called Serena, there we will take a very delicious lunch. You will also have the chance to buy handicrafts like jewelry, made of seeds, natural fibres and colours. The quality and the design is perfect and the price is very low.
- We will visit a native family where you can see and live our customs. You will discover a very big tree closed to the river, the guide will explain a lot of plants, especially those of medical use.
